**F**uneral Service for Mrs. Katherine Ann Brown, 80, of Goodwater, Alabama, will be held Thursday, March 7, 2024 at 1:00 pm at the Hackneyville Baptist Church. Dr. Albert Pike will officiate. Burial will follow in the Hackneyville Cemetery. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service.
