Rosario "Ross" Bellino, a cherished family man, respected veteran, and passionate restorer of vintage cars, passed away at the age of 88, surrounded by his family. Born to the late Vincenzo "James" Bellino and Pasqualina (Palozzi) Bellino. Ross's life was one marked by dedication and service. 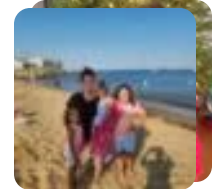
