He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Judith Ann Spence; and son, Gregory Michael Spence.

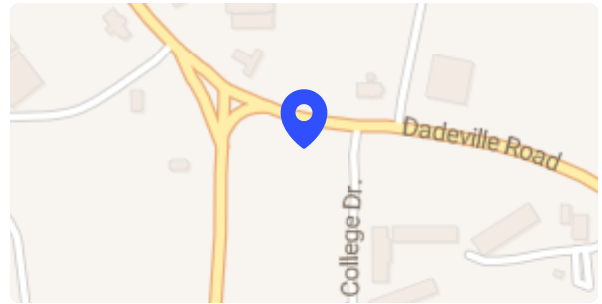

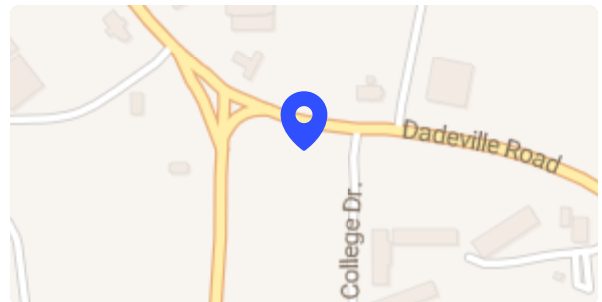
