**F**uneral Service for Rev. Roger Green, 75, of Goodwater, Alabama, will be Friday, December 27, 2024, at 2:00 pm at the God's House Church. Rev. Green will lie in state at the church from 1:00 pm until 2:00 pm prior to the service. Dr. Josh Sammons, Rev. Donald DeLee and Bro. Neal Smith will officiate. Burial will follow in the Old Providence Baptist Church Cemetery. The family will receive friends on Thursday, December 26, 2024, from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm at Radney Funeral Home.

Rev. Roger Green, a cherished spiritual leader, devoted family man, and passionate sports enthusiast, passed away surrounded by his loving family. Born with a heart full of joy and wisdom, Roger's presence was a beacon of love and laughter for all who knew him.

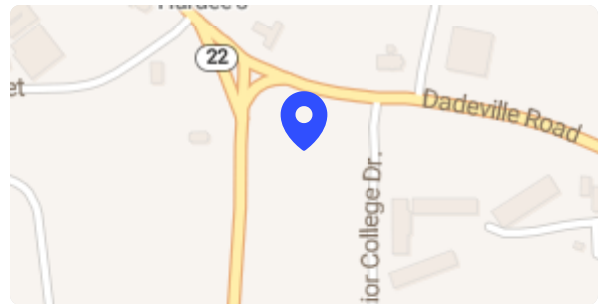

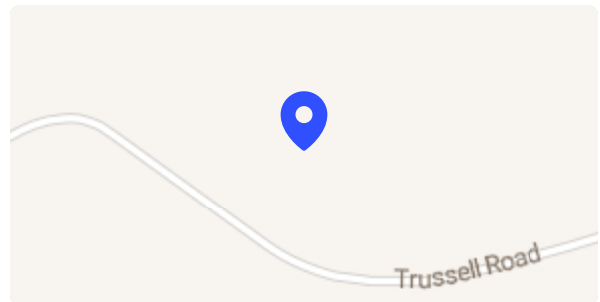
