He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Linda Kelly; son, Daniel Kelly; sisters, Mary Strickland and Avis Barker.

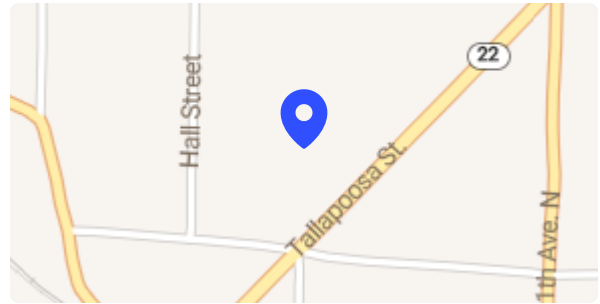

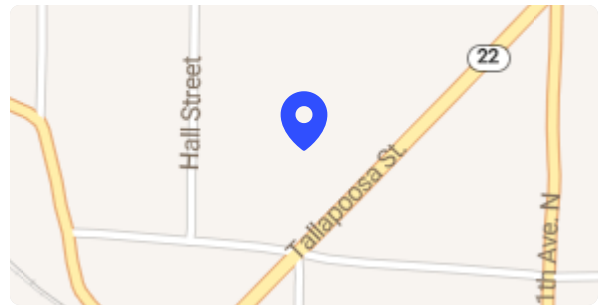
