for life was evident in her everyday activities and the way she embraced every experience with enthusiasm.

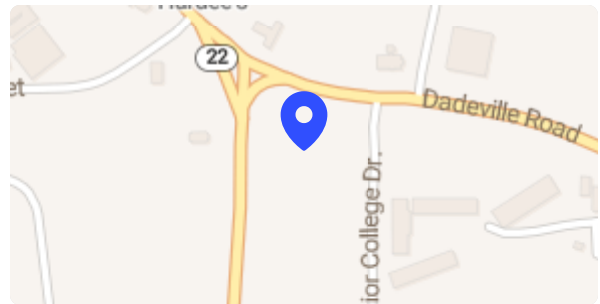

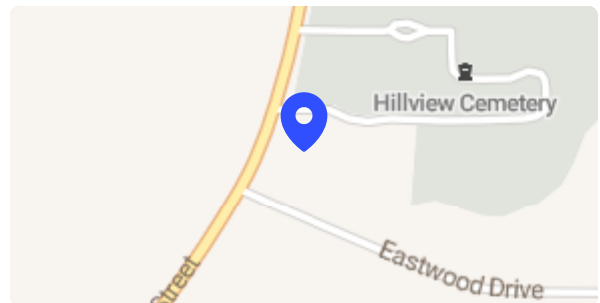

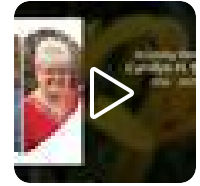
