Gloria Wayne Corley Wilson was born on August 18, 1939, to Benjamin H. and Ernestine E. (Ingram) Corley at Russell Hospital, Alexander City, Alabama. She passed away at home March 19, 2025 after a short battle with cancer. Gloria started school at Avondale and graduated from Benjamin Russell High School, class of 1957. She enjoyed the Avondale and Russell High school reunions.

Gloria married her first sweetheart, E. Nolen Daniel; to this union daughters Susan and Stacy, and son Scott were born. 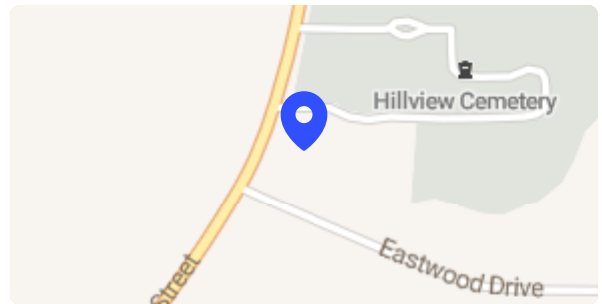

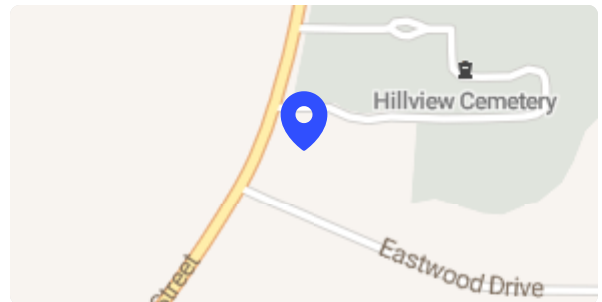
