career as an insurance salesman for Mutual Savings. His professional life was marked not only by his achievements but also by the relationships he built and the trust he earned from his colleagues and clients.

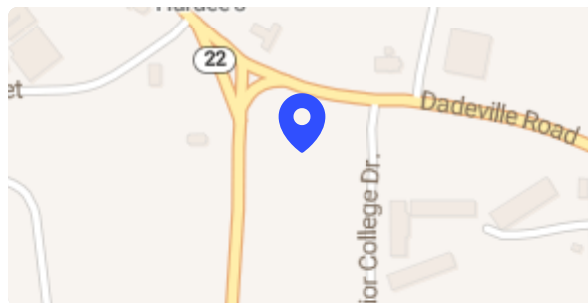

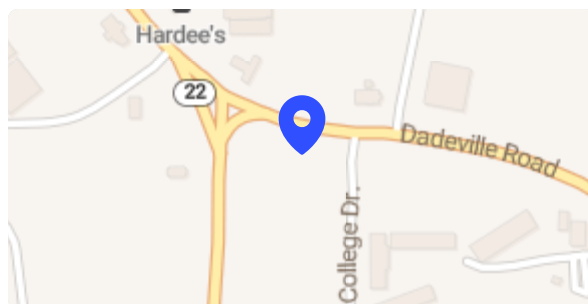

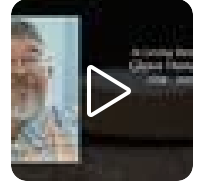
