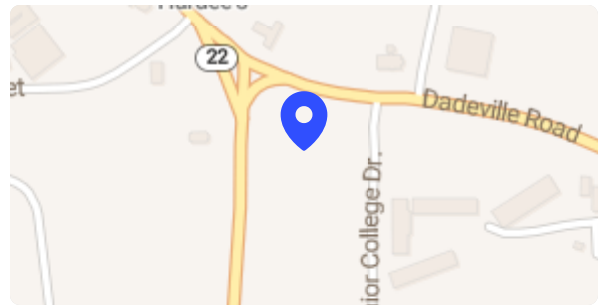
strength he displayed in many times of adversity. His friendly demeanor made him a beloved figure of many, where he was known for his sense of humor and love of others.

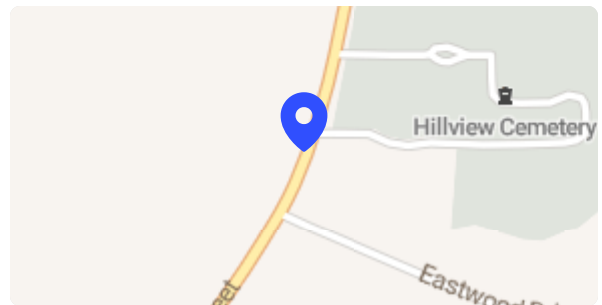
