The family would like to extend a heartfelt "Thank You" to the wonderful staff at Chapman's Assisted Living for the wonderful care given to their loved one.



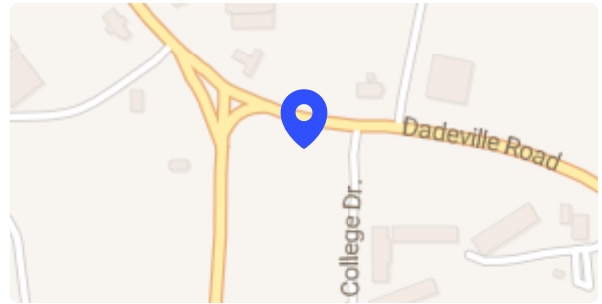
