Mrs. Pescia was called to her heavenly home on March 3, 2026. Born on May 6, 1939, in the quaint town of Dullingham, England to William Leslie Jacobs and Thelma E.L. Davey Jacobs Pennington, Shirley's life was a testament to her unwavering faith and the love she cultivated around her. 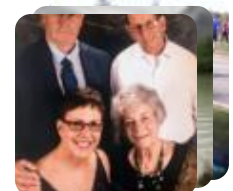
