Carolyn Hamby Patterson, age 91, of Alexander City, Alabama, passed away peacefully on March 18, 2026, at Brown Nursing Home, surrounded by her loving family.

Funeral services for Ms. Patterson will be held graveside at Dadeville City Cemetery on Friday, March 20, 2026 at 2:00 pm.

Ms. Patterson was born on April 12, 1934, in Autauga County, Alabama. She grew up in Dadeville, Alabama, and was the eldest of her nine beloved siblings. 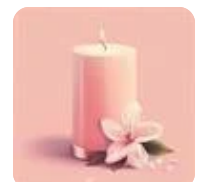
